
THE REAL CHALLENGE IS REDUCING A YACHT TO HER ESSENTIALS

The redesigned cockpit layout — with a clear, asymmetric entrance and increased space between the helm consoles and winches — enhances flow, safety, and efficiency under sail. All halyards and sheets are led aft to the helm stations, ensuring easy and safe handling at all times. Combined with her optimized ballast ratio, these features make the Y7 not only extremely stable but also a true pleasure to sail. She now also features a U-shaped sofa on the starboard side for greater comfort. With increased interior volume, versatile new layout options, and smart design upgrades above and below deck, the Y7 continues to set the benchmark in her segment.





Below deck, the engine room has been moved from beneath the saloon floor to a dedicated technical space with dual access, including direct entry from the crew area. The crew companionway continues the proven concept of its predecessor, yet with even greater refinement. Elegantly integrated into the cockpit design, it remains almost invisible at first glance while providing the crew with direct access to both cockpit and helm stations. This separation of pathways ensures that owners and guests enjoy maximum privacy, while the crew can work efficiently and discreetly.



A larger interior volume and a significantly enhanced master cabin are available in three different layout options. Owners can choose between a new VIP guest cabin or a generous crew area with crew mess, offering maximum flexibility depending on individual requirements.




YOUR INDIVIDUAL YACHT LAYOUT



There are numerous individual options for configuring the layout of a Y7 below deck. In the standard arrangement, the owner's cabin is located forward and features a free-standing bed, two spacious wardrobes, and an en-suite bathroom in the bow. Amidships, the generous salon offers a dining area to starboard and a comfortable lounge sofa to port. A U-shaped galley is positioned on the starboard side, opposite a relaxation area with an L-shaped sofa. Aft, the new Y7 now features a crew mess and two twin guest cabins. Both cabins include their own en-suite bathrooms. In place of the crew mess and the starboard guest cabin, discerning owners may instead select a spacious VIP suite with an elegant double bed. The proven and popular YYachts workspace in the salon also remains available as an option for those who wish to combine leisure with functionality.







Master cabin & bathroom en-suite
